28. REDUCTION OF 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR STATE AID

Motion to approve the resolution to address the loss of state aid for the fiscal year 2017-2018.

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2017 school districts received notice of revised 2017-2018 state aid and the guidance to address this change requiring action by August 1, 2017;

WHEREAS, the Linwood Board of Education received notice that the district's aid has been reduced by \$31,594 in the categorical aid line of Adjustment Aid;

WHEREAS, the Linwood Board of Education has determined two non-instructional positions included in the budget will not be replaced for the 2017-2018 school year;

WHEREAS, the 2017-2018 budget lines of 11-000-262-107 Salaries of Other Aides will be reduced \$14,505, and 11-000-291-220 Benefits will be reduced \$1,109;

WHEREAS, the Linwood Board of Education has determined not to fill the new position included in the 2017-2018 budget;

WHEREAS, the 2017-2018 budget line of 11-000-291-270 Benefits will be reduced \$15,980;

THEREFORE, be it resolved, the Linwood Board of Education will reduce the 2017-2018 School year Budget \$31,594 to address the loss of state aid.
